We wanted to remind you about arrangements for contacting us about positive Covid19 cases during the school holidays.

**Contacting School about positive Covid-19 cases during the school holidays**

We have been advised by DFE to ensure staff, parents and carers are aware of the information and relevant arrangements regarding positive cases in the holidays; Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school does not need to be contacted during the holiday. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

If a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school. All children will return to school on **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June.**
