### Year 6 Transition Arrangements – Ryedale School

I wanted to take this opportunity to remind you of the dates and clarify a few additional points. Please note that the schools **will NOT be providing transport** to these events so parents need to ensure arrangements are in place.

#### Literacy Day – Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June

I can confirm that both Hovingham and St Hilda's pupils are scheduled to attend on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June from 11.30am – 3.00pm. Please ensure that pupils are collected from school in plenty of time and that they either have some money (£2.50-£3.00) or a packed lunch. They do not need to return to school at the end of the day.

#### Ryedale School Open Evening – Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> July

An evening for Year 6 pupils and their parents starting at 7:00pm.

#### Induction Day – Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> July

Pupils do not need to attend school on this day but should go directly to Ryedale School arriving between 9:30am & 9:45am. They need to take writing equipment, and either lunch money or a packed lunch. They need to be collected at 3:00pm

#### Activities Afternoon – Friday 16<sup>th</sup> July

Pupils should be collected from school in order to arrive at Ryedale School between 1:45 and 1:55pm. They need to wear their PE kit and be collected at 3:00pm. They do not need to return to school.
