Being a school governor is a challenging but hugely rewarding role. By volunteering, it gives you the chance to make a real difference to children, give something back to your community, and use and develop your skills in a board-level environment.

At present the Federation is especially looking for people who can bring financial experience or experience of strategic leadership. You would need enough free time to give to the role, but no previous experience of the education system.
